

## Instant Powder Kegs Dilution and Mixing Instructions

Instant Powder Kegs coil cleaner is so easy to use. We've pre-measured it for you, so you don't have to be concerned about that part of the process. Each cloth bag of Instant Powder Kegs contain 6- 4 oz Kegs.

### Mixing For Best Results

Pour a single Keg into an empty one gallon sprayer. Fill your sprayer about half way with water, put the cover on tight and give it a good shake. Now you can fill with more water. If you want to add another Keg (see cleaning strength guide below) go ahead, adding one at a time and remember to give the sprayer a real good shake in between each keg addition.

To help with the dissolving process, after you have added all of the Kegs you intend, wait 5 to 10 minutes and give another good shake before using, Sprayers will not spray undissolved materials.

**Note:** It is normal for the mixture to heat up a bit as you add to and mix the solution.

The average coil take 2 - 3 Kegs to clean. If your coil is not that dirty, you should try just one Keg at first. Coil cleaners, by nature, are corrosive so in this case, less is more.

When you start to clean the coil, if you notice the coil was dirtier that you originally thought, go ahead and add another keg or two. Just make sure you have vigorously in between each one.
